

Transportation Authorization Legislation - 111th Congress

Member High Priority Projects Submitted

- **City of Galion – Portland Way Road Widening Project**

Summary: Widening from 2 lanes to 3 lanes of Portland Way (SR 598/SR 61/SR 309) within the City of Galion between Boyd Avenue and Heise Park Lane

Amount Submitted: \$2,254,240

- **Henry County Engineer – New Maumee River Crossing Project**

Summary: Funds will be used for planning, permitting and designing a new river bridge. The bridge will connect Napoleon's 2 industrial areas and allow for traffic from the South industrial area to reach the new US 24.

Amount Submitted: \$2,900,000

- **Huron County Engineer – Peru Center Road**

Summary: There are 2 phases to the project – the first phase will provide all engineering, environmental, field surveys and soil investigation work to develop feasible alternatives to repair 7 roadway embankments slide area on east side of Peru Road. Phase 2 will be the construction activities to make permanent road repairs to the 7 slide areas.

Amount Submitted: \$250,000 for Phase 1 study

- **City of Norwalk – West Emerald Parkway – Re-designation of former US 20 Bypass Study Project**

Summary: A new roadway connecting US Route 250 to a City of Norwalk owned Right of Way. This existing city Right of Way will be improved in upcoming phases of development to be a rear-access roadway to commercial properties on US Route 250 improving access management in compliance with the City's Comprehensive plan. The proposed intersection of the new street at US Route 250 will be directly across from the new East Emerald Parkway which traverses through the planned Norwalk Commons development.

Amount Requested: \$500,000

- **City of Perrysburg – I-475 and SR 25 Interchange and Corridor Improvements**

Summary: Interchange upgrade for I-475 and SR 25 including reconfiguration of the ramps and/or lane additions to the ramps to address capacity needs, widening of the SR 25 bridge over I-475 to add capacity to the interchange and SR 25, turn lane additions to SR 25 at the I-475 interchange to add capacity to the interchange, aesthetic components to the interchange and signal upgrades.

Amount Requested: \$3,000,000

- **Village of Leipsic – Rail Extension**

Summary: Phase III will extend the Village's track 2 from its present location north to State Route 65 approximately 1000 feet. Extend the Village of Leipsic's track 3 from its present north ending point north an additional 2500 feet. The Village would also construct track 4 parallel to the Norfolk Southern Railroad and provide turnouts into additional zoned industrial land in this area. This track would be 2160 feet in length and would include two turnouts into this industrial area.

Amount Requested: \$8,400,000

- **Sandusky County – Resurfacing of Sandusky County Road 41**

Summary: This project will include resurfacing as well as pavement planning, shoulder improvements, paint striping and installation of raised pavement markers.

Amount Requested: \$1,320,000

- **Seneca County Engineer – County Road 38 Bridge Replacement Project**

Summary: This project is to replace a structurally deficient bridge on the Federal Aid Highway System. The money will be used for engineering design services and construction across the Scenic Sandusky River.

Amount Requested: \$1,675,650
