## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Commerce to conduct a study and submit to Congress a report on the state of the internet-connected devices industry in the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "State of Modern Appli-
- 5 cation, Research, and Trends of IoT Act" or the "SMART
- 6 IoT Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. STUDY AND REPORT ON INTERNET OF THINGS.

2	(a) Study.—The Secretary of Commerce shall con-
3	duct a study on the state of the internet-connected devices
4	industry (commonly known as the "Internet of Things")
5	in the United States. In conducting the study, the Sec-
6	retary shall—
7	(1) develop a comprehensive list of Federal
8	agencies with jurisdiction over entities in the indus-
9	$\operatorname{try};$
10	(2) develop a description of the jurisdiction and
11	expertise of such agencies over such entities; and
12	(3) conduct a survey of entities in the internet-
13	connected devices industry to—
14	(A) identify which Federal agencies such
15	entities interact with;
16	(B) identify public-private partnerships fo-
17	cused on promoting the adoption and use of
18	internet-connected devices;
19	(C) identify Federal Government resources
20	that exist for consumers and small businesses
21	to evaluate internet-connected devices; and
22	(D) identify what, if any, duplication exists
23	in the jurisdiction and expertise of Federal
24	agencies listed under paragraph (1) over enti-
25	ties in the internet-connected devices industry.

1	(b) Report to Congress.—Not later than 2 years
2	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
3	shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce
4	of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
5	Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a
6	report that contains—
7	(1) the results of the study conducted under
8	subsection (a); and
9	(2) recommendations of the Secretary for re-
10	ducing any existing duplication in jurisdiction or ex-
11	pertise as identified under subsection (a)(3)(D).
12	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
13	(1) FEDERAL AGENCY.—The term "Federal
14	agency" means an agency, as defined in section 551
15	of title 5, United States Code.
16	(2) Internet-connected device.—The term
17	"internet-connected device" means a physical object
18	that—
19	(A) is capable of connecting to the inter-
20	net, either directly or indirectly through a net-
21	work, to communicate information at the direc-
22	tion of an individual; and
23	(B) has computer processing capabilities
24	for collecting, sending, receiving, or analyzing
25	data.
